

Monroe Hospital COVID

- Monroe County requires face masks indoors in all public places per the Monroe County Public Health Regulation and Order. This pertains to both vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals.
- All visitors and patients must be screened for COVID prior to entering the facility.
- The Front Lobby is open M-F from 0800 am to 1600 pm; Otherwise, it is closed and all patients and visitors must enter through the ER entrance.
- No limitations on the number of visitors per day but limited to 2 at a time (NON-COVID visitors ONLY). For COVID patients each person must wear full hospital-acquired PPE and receive approval from Administrator.
- All persons in the facility must wear a face covering at all times.

Your safety is our priority. Due to the current wave of COVID-19, healthcare facilities throughout the area are experiencing high volumes of patients. Staff members, like the community at large, are being impacted by COVID-19, resulting in a higher than normal number sick calls. To ensure that we have safe staffing levels to care for our patients, we are following the CDCs guidance for healthcare personnel shortages.
